- » Have a minimum of a basic understanding of pneumatics and hydraulics

#### Your responsibilities

- » Ensure where applicable, that plant is designed, installed, tested and commissioned in accordance with the contract conditions and that appropriate records are produced throughout
- » Provide report information for the monthly Executive / Board meeting giving details on present project progress, new projects and issues
- » Maintain awareness and ensure full compliance with health and safety legislation, and Company rules and policies.
